"That the life also of Jesus might be made manifest in our mortal flesh." 2 Corinthians 4:10, 11. Note carefully: It is now while we are in "mortal flesh" that Christ is to be manifest in our mortal flesh.

When Christ returns then **"This mortal shall put on immortality", 1 Corinthians 15:51-54.** but it is while we have mortal flesh Christ is to be made manifest in our bodies.

"As many as received Him, to them gave He power." John 1:12.

"We receive righteousness by receiving Him." Mount of Blessings, page 34

"Their righteousness is of Me, saith the Lord." Isaiah 54:17.

"The righteousness of God is embodied in Christ." Mount of Blessings, page 34. Christ in us produces righteousness in the life. Christ thus empowers us to obey, and obedience is the sign of Christ within.

"Thy law is within my heart." Psalm 40:6-9.

Christ had God's law in His heart. When Christ comes into our heart and life He brings God's law of righteousness. Then the life of Christ becomes manifest in our life.

"Righteousness is holiness, likeness to God, for all Thy commandments are righteousness." Mount of Blessings, page 34.

"The heavens shall declare His righteousness." Psalm 50:6.

"The heavens declare the glory of God; and the firmament sheweth his handywork." Psalm 19:1. They will yet declare His righteousness.

"Then there appears against the sky a hand holding two tables of stone folded together. Says the prophet "The heavens shall declare His righteousness for God is Judge Himself." That holy law, God's righteousness, that amid thunder and flame was proclaimed from Sinai as the guide of life, is now revealed to men as the rule of judgment. The hand opens the tables, and there are seen the precepts of the Ten Commandments, traced as with a pen of fire. The words are so plain that all can read them. Memory is aroused, the darkness of superstition and heresy is swept from every mind, and God's ten words, brief, comprehensive, and authoritative, are presented to the view of all the inhabitants of the earth. "It is impossible to describe the horror and despair of those who have trampled upon God's holy requirements. The Lord gave them His law; they might have compared their characters with it, and learned their defects while there was yet opportunity for repentance and reform; but in order to secure the favor of the world, they set aside its precepts and taught others to transgress." "This crisis will be reached when the nations shall unite in making void God's law." 5 Testimonies, page 524. How tragic! What deception! Are some professed Seventh-day Adventists joining this apostasy?

God has a people who "Keep the Commandments of God." Revelation 14:12.

"Where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty." 2 Corinthians 3:17. Liberty to obey Christ. Liberty because Christ with His "Law of Liberty is in our mortal body.

We "are changed into the same image by the Spirit of the Lord." 2 Corinthians 3:18.

"Jesus our Lord has given unto us all things that pertain unto life and godliness that by these ye might be partakers of the divine nature." 2 Peter 1:2-4.

Matthew

5:19 Whosoever therefore shall break one of these least **commandments**, and shall teach men so, he shall be called the least in the kingdom of heaven: but whosoever shall do and teach them, the same shall be called great in the kingdom of heaven.

19:17 And he said unto him, Why call you me good? There is none good but one, that is, God: but if you wilt enter into life, keep the **commandments**.

22:40 On these two **commandments** hang all the **law** and the prophets.

Mark

10:19 Thou know the **commandments**, Do not commit adultery, Do not kill, Do not steal, Do not bear false witness, Defraud not, Honor thy father and mother.

12:29 And Jesus answered him, The first of all the **commandments** is, Hear, O Israel; The Lord our God is one Lord:

Luke

1:6 And they were both righteous before God, walking in all the **commandments** and ordinances of the Lord blameless.

18:20 Thou know the **commandments**, Do not commit adultery, Do not kill, Do not steal, Do not bear false witness, Honor thy father and thy mother.

John

14:15 If you love me, keep my **commandments**.

14:21 He that has my **commandments**, and keeps them, he it is that loves me: and he that loves me shall be loved of my Father, and I will love him, and will manifest myself to him.

15:10 If you keep my **commandments**, you shall abide in my love; even as I have kept my Father's **commandments**, and abide in his love.

Acts

1:2 Until the day in which he was taken up, after that he through the Holy Ghost had given **commandments** unto the apostles whom he had chosen:

7:53 Who have received the **law** by the disposition of angels, and have not kept it.

13:15 And after the reading of the **law** and the prophets the rulers of the synagogue sent unto them, saying, You men and brethren, if you have any word of exhortation for the people, say on.

21:20 And when they heard it, they glorified the Lord, and said unto him.

21:24 Them take, and purify thyself with them, and be at charges with them, that they may shave their heads: and all may know that those things, whereof they were informed concerning you, are nothing; but that you thyself also walk orderly, and keeps the **law**.

24:14 But this I confess unto you, that after the way which they call heresy, so worship I the God of my fathers, believing all things which are written in the **law** and in the prophets:

25:8 While he answered for himself, Neither against the **law** of the Jews, neither against the temple, nor yet against Caesar, have I offended any thing at all.

Romans

2:12 For as many as have sinned without **law** shall also perish without **law**: and as many as have sinned in the **law** shall be judged by the **law**;

2:13 (For not the hearers of the **law** are just before God, but the doers of the **law** shall be justified.

2:14 For when the Gentiles, which have not the **law**, do by nature the things contained in the **law**, these, having not the **law**, are a **law** unto themselves.

2:15 Which show the work of the **law** written in their hearts, their conscience also bearing witness, and their thoughts the mean while accusing or else excusing one another;

2:17 Behold, you art called a Jew, and rests in the **law**, and makes thy boast of God,

2:18 And know his will, and approves the things that are more excellent, being instructed out of the **law**.

2:20 An instructor of the foolish, a teacher of babes, which has the form of knowledge and of the truth in the **law**.

2:23 Thou that makes thy boast of the **law**, through breaking the **law** dishonors you God?

3:19 Now we know that what things so ever the **law** said, it said to them who are under the **law**: that every mouth may be stopped, and all the world may become guilty before God

3:20 Therefore by the deeds of the **law** there shall no flesh be justified in his sight: for by the **law** is the knowledge of sin.

3:21 But now the righteousness of God without the **law** is manifested, being witnessed by the **law** and the prophets;

3:27 Where is boasting then? It is excluded. By what **law**? of works? Nay: but by the **law** of faith.

3:28 Therefore we conclude that a man is justified by faith without the deeds of the **law**.

3:31 Do we then make void the **law** through faith? God forbid: yea, we establish the **law**.

4:15 Because the **law** works wrath: for where no **law** is, there is no transgression.

5:13 (For until the **law** sin was in the world: but sin is not imputed when there is no **law**.)

5:20 Moreover the **law** entered, that the offence might abound. But where sin abounded, grace did much more abound:

6:14 For sin shall not have dominion over you: for you are not under the **law**, but under grace.

7:1 Know you not, brethren, (for I speak to them that know the **law**,) how that the **law** has dominion over a man as long as he lives?

7:3 So then if, while her husband lives, she be married to another man, she shall be called an adulteress: but if her husband be dead, she is free from that **law**; so that she is no adulteress, though she be married to another man.

7:7 What shall we say then? is the **law** sin? God forbid. Nay, I had not known sin, but by the **law**: for I had not known lust, except the **law** had said, Thou shall not covet.

7:8 But sin, taking occasion by the commandment, wrought in me all manner of concupiscence. For with out the **law** sin was dead.

7:9 For I was alive without the **law** once: but when the commandment came, sin revived, and I died.

7:12 Wherefore the **law** is holy, and the commandment holy, and just, and good.

7:14 For we know that the **law** is spiritual: but I am carnal, sold under sin.

7:16 If then I do that which I would not, I consent unto the **law** that it is good.

7:22 For I delight in the **law** of God after the inward man:

7:25 I thank God through Jesus Christ our Lord. So then with the mind I myself serve the **law** of God; but with the flesh the **law** of sin.

8:2 For the **law** of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has made me free from the **law** of sin and death.

8:3 For what the **law** could not do, in that it was weak through the flesh, God sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, and for sin, condemned sin in the flesh:

8:4 That the righteousness of the **law** might be fulfilled in us, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.

8:7 Because the carnal mind is enmity against God: for it is not subject to the **law** of God, neither indeed can be.

13:8 Owe no man any thing, but to love one another: for he that loves another has fulfilled the **law**.

13:9 For this, Thou shall not commit adultery, Thou shall not kill, Thou shall not steal, Thou shall not bear false witness, Thou shall not covet; and if there be any other commandment, it is briefly comprehended in this saying, namely, Thou shall love thy neighbor as thyself.

13:10 Love works no ill to his neighbor: therefore love is the fulfilling of the **law**.

1 Corinthians

7:19 Circumcision is nothing, and uncircumcision is nothing, but the keeping of the **commandments** of God.

14:37 If any man think himself to be a prophet, or spiritual, let him acknowledge that the things that I write unto you are the **commandments** of the Lord.

1 Thessalonians

4:2 For you know what **commandments** we gave you by the Lord Jesus.

1 John

2:3 And hereby we do know that we know him, if we keep his **commandments**.

2:4 He that said, I know him, and keeps not his **commandments**, is a liar, and the truth is not in him.

3:22 And whatsoever we ask, we receive of him, because we keep his **commandments**, and do those things that are pleasing in his sight.

3:24 And he that keeps his **commandments** dwells in him, and he in him. And hereby we know that he abides in us, by the Spirit which he has given us.

5:2 By this we know that we love the children of God, when we love God, and keep his **commandments**.

5:3 For this is the love of God, that we keep his **commandments**: and his **commandments** are not grievous.

2 John

1:6 And this is love, that we walk after his **commandments**. This is the commandment, That, as you have heard from the beginning, you should walk in it.

Revelation

11:19 And the temple of God was opened in heaven, and there was seen in his temple the **ark of his testament**: and there were lightning, and voices, and thundering, and an earthquake, and great hail.

12:17 And the dragon was wroth with the woman, and went to make war with the remnant of her seed, which keep the **commandments** of God, and have the testimony of Jesus Christ.

14:12 Here is the patience of the saints: here are they that keep the **commandments** of God, and the faith of Jesus.

15:5 And after that I looked, and, behold, the temple of the **tabernacle of the testimony** in heaven was opened:

22:14 Blessed are they that do his **commandments**, that they may have right to the tree of life, and may enter in through the gates into the city.
