

“Yea, Hath God Said?”

“If the foundations be destroyed, what can the righteous do?” Psalm 11.3.

You probably recognize this as the serpent-devil’s first words to Eve. He is still using this same trap today and still with great success. How does it work? Here’s a selection from a video documentary by two researchers about the two main false manuscripts that are behind the modern Bible versions. The Big question for us all as Christians is, Do we believe God’s Word, or a bunch of worldly scholars that don’t believe it and actually hate it?

You will hear two big names, Codex Sinaiticus and Codex Vaticanus. These are claimed to be older than our Protestant KJV Bible manuscripts, [the received text] but the evidence we have now in the last 10-20 years is they are both fakes! The ‘scholars’ claim they are both from the 300’s AD, and yet there is no proof or evidence of this at all! It seems rather that Codex Vaticanus is actually from the 1400s and Codex Sinaiticus is from the 1800’s so certainly the manuscripts for our KJV are much older and also there are thousands of them compared to just 3 or 4 of the other kinds.

It's like Evolution and Darwinism, where they say, “Of course the dinosaur bones are millions and millions of years old.” Even children ‘know’ that! That's what you're told and so that's what you end up believing. Unless you have learned the truth about it! there is no good evidence at all for evolution that isn’t better explained in other ways! There was a famous writer who said, “It’s not what people don’t know that is a problem, it’s what they ‘know’ that isn’t so!” They believe it because ‘scholars’, ‘experts’ and scientists and text books teach it, but it isn’t true!

In the video the researcher was telling how he started to doubt what the ‘Scholars and experts’ were saying about these 2 so called, ‘oldest’ Manuscripts. [a ‘Manuscript’ is a hand-written document.] He said, “I thought, well wait a minute, the way he's saying that, just immediately made me suspicious. It made me begin to question, ‘Okay, well how do they know this? And that led me into this whole method of dating these documents and uncovering the methods they claimed proved it.” He learned there was no true evidence at all for what they were claiming!

The Bible warns us about false ‘science’. “O Timothy, keep that which is committed to thy trust, avoiding profane and vain babblings, and oppositions of science falsely so called: Which some professing have erred concerning the faith.” 1 Timothy 6:20, 21.

Selected from the documentary about this subject. “Next question: How does codex Siniaticus impact the church and world's impression of the Bible? That is a great question, in fact as I said it's the straw that broke the camel's back. It was that last little bit that allowed all the paleography scholars, all the Christian and pseudo [false]-Christian scholars of paleography [studying old documents] and textual criticism and stuff to finally let the pieces fall where they may, change the Bible, turn away people from this Bible, [KJV] the revealed word of God, that has been passed down at the cost of people's lives through history, to switch to one that was also agreeable to the Catholic Church.

The Siniaticus allowed people to have debates now, and say. “Now we know there's certain things that definitely should not have been in this KJV Bible”, and that's all they needed to start with. “Yea hath God said?” Clearly that's a trick that has worked since the garden of Eden. “Yea hath God said?” Once you give people that question, you move them onto a path of four steps:

The first is confusion; “Yea hath God said?” Did He really say that?

The second one is doubt, “I don't know if God said.”

The third one is disbelief, "I don't believe God said that."

And fourth is rebellion, "I'm going to go my own way; I'm going to figure it out for myself."

You can see how that is exactly what Eve did! And the devil doesn't care what step you're on, as long as you're on this path, as opposed to F-A-I-T-H, faith in God through the Lord Jesus Christ. God wants us to have the Christian faith not the Christian doubt! He wants us to grow in faith, and He wants us to grow by actually knowing what He said. That's why He said, "Don't add to what I said; don't take away from what I said!" if you add to His words, "Add not to His words, lest He reprove thee and thou be found a liar." Proverbs 30. Solomon said that. "Do not add nor diminish a word that's from Deuteronomy 4:2. God said it through Moses. Jeremiah 26:2. He said "diminish not a word," when he was supposed to speak.

And then of course the Revelation 22:18, 19. For I testify unto every man that heareth the words of the prophecy of this book, If any man shall add "unto these things, God shall add unto him the plagues that are written in this book: And if any man shall take away from the words of the book of this prophecy, God shall take away his part out of the book of life, and out of the holy city, and from the things which are written in this book."

Now how can you know if with all those warnings in the Bible through Deuteronomy, so you've got the law, you've got Jeremiah and others, the prophets, you've got it in the Psalms, in the writings in Solomon and you have it in the New Testament not to add to and Jesus said, "Heaven and earth shall pass away, but My Word shall not pass away." Mark 13:31.

Well what words are those that didn't pass away? Why is it all of a sudden we have to go looking in monasteries, and graveyards, and caves, and dig down in the dirt, to find scraps of paper that are supposed to be God's Word, when God said He was going to preserve it? and in fact the original thing before it got changed! "The words of the LORD are pure words: as silver tried in a furnace of earth, purified seven times. Thou shalt keep them, O LORD, thou shalt preserve them from this generation for ever." Psalm 12:6, 7.

Well how can you know if you added to or taken away from God's words unless you have them? Then you can know if you added to them because you already have them. So that meant for me in my research, is that that means they have to exist somewhere and all I have to do is find them. Where are they, and they have to be someplace that's not hidden and in plain sight. Well yeah well here it is! I'm holding it in my hand. [KJV] I can know these are God's words.

But the devil wants doubt, he never wants you to have faith, he wants the opposite side and doubt, and Siniaticus absolutely played into this, because once they did this, the scholars then could say, "We have evidence and verification that these things don't belong." And once they start that, you're now trusting a scholar over the history and the power of the Word of God!

Then that scholar can tell you, Oh this also, and this also, and this also, doesn't belong, and it really should say this not that!" That was the straw, that was the straw, and it was by Siniaticus that suddenly Vaticanus became the thing. Wow!

The Bible says, "And Jesus answered him, [Satan] saying, It is written, That man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word of God." Luke 4:4. We sure cannot live by them unless we have them, can we? Can we think that God, the great Creator of heaven and earth, Who rules the universe and keeps all the millions of star-suns and planets in order, would be so careless as to tell us we must live by His Word, and that "Thy word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path." Psalm 119:105. And then

allow His Word to be so lost and messed up that we don't even know what it is or where it is, and we need worldly 'scholars' and Jesuit Priests to tell us what God says, and they don't even believe in Him really themselves?

The Bible says, "But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him." Hebrews 11:6. Faith is believing that 1, God is, that is He exists, He is real. 2, God rewards those who seek to know Him. You can't seek someone you don't believe is real!

God Promises; "Heaven and earth shall pass away: but my words shall not pass away." Luke 21:33.

"The words of the LORD are pure words: as silver tried in a furnace of earth, purified seven times. Thou shalt keep them, O LORD, thou shalt preserve them from this generation for ever." Psalm 12:6, 7.

"Every word of God is pure: he is a shield unto them that put their trust in him." Proverbs 30:5. We can put our trust in someone if we don't know if they said something or not!

So over and over we see the every Word of God is important and so someone who comes along and wants to remove hundreds of Words and sentences and even whole sections, and change what's left, we can know they are the devil's agent!

Jesus warned, "He that rejecteth me, and receiveth not my words, hath one that judgeth him: the word that I have spoken, the same shall judge him in the last day." John 12:48. Oh my! So would God say He was going to judge us by His Word, and yet He knew we did not have His word and would have to wait hundreds of years until some modern scholars, who did not even believe in it, could hunt through monasteries and junk heaps and find bits and pieces and then glue them together for us so we could have God's word? And then even at that they all argue with each other about it and do not agree that what they found is God's word?

The one thing they all agree on is they want to get rid of the KJV, which they hate. It was the same in Jesus' day, the different rulers and scholars did not agree and fought with each other all the time. The only thing they did agree on was they wanted to get rid of Jesus! It is the same thing, the devil does not care how many different lies you want to believe, but he is determined that God's truth be gotten rid of, along with those who believe it and live by it!

There is real power in the True Word of God. "The world is full of all manner of error of a misleading nature, and it is essential that both pupils and teachers know that they know what is truth. There is need that we reverence the Word of God and recognize His voice in the living oracles, that we may practise its precepts and live by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God. Those that do the will of God shall know of the doctrine whether it be of God, for no deception will cloud their minds. God calls every one, both old and young, to make a diligent search in His Word, that they may discover the rich jewels of truth. Ministers and people, teachers and scholars, are all called to the work of studying the Bible." TSS 64.

What is the secret of understanding the Bible? "If any man will do his will, he shall know of the doctrine, whether it be of God, or whether I speak of myself." John 7:17. It is very simple, a person must want to know the Word of God so they can obey it! Unless we are willing to obey the truth, we will never really understand it! But a little child can understand God's word when he wants to obey Jesus. "And that from a child thou hast known the holy scriptures, which are able to make thee wise unto salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus." 2 Timothy 3:15.
